In a business planning process, the planning team typically includes the CEO and top financial manager (CFO or COO). It may also include other senior staff or program staff with specialized knowledge of the proposed activity; board members; middle managers; and/or front-line staff. In a partnership situation, it would typically include representatives from each potential partner or group of partners.

Begin by identifying any specific skills, knowledge, experience, or connections you will need, then think about what mix of individuals will best provide those while also working well as a team.
